Topic for August: Ride Hard, Drink Smart

Hot weather rides can be deceiving. Wind in your face makes it *feel* cooler, but under the gear—especially in stop-and-go traffic—your body is working overtime to regulate temperature.

And while most riders are great at topping up the gas tank, too many forget to fuel their most important engine: **themselves**.

Why It Matters

Dehydration Impairs Focus: Just 1–2% fluid loss can reduce mental sharpness and reaction time—critical on two wheels.

Muscle Fatigue Kicks In Faster: Cramps, shakiness, and exhaustion can creep up fast in the heat.

Gear Traps Heat: Even lightweight mesh jackets and summer gloves increase your body's workload to stay cool.

And it's not just about water—**electrolytes** help your body absorb and retain that hydration so it can function properly.

Hydration Tips for Hot Rides

- **Preload**: Start hydrating **before** you ride—not after you feel thirsty.
- **Sip Often**: Carry a water bottle or hydration pack and make regular stops to rehydrate.
- **Include Electrolytes**: Especially on long rides, plain water isn't always enough. Supplement with an electrolyte mix to replenish salt and minerals.
- Watch for Signs: Dry mouth, dizziness, lightheadedness, or headache = you're already behind.
