Junuary – Preparing for Rapid Weather Changes

Don't Let the Forecast Fool You

Sometimes June can feel more like January—hence the nickname **"Junuary."** While the calendar may say summer is near, the skies often disagree. Sudden rain showers, temperature swings, gusty winds, and even fog can all be part of the ride this month.

We don't just check the forecast—we ride through it. So being ready for rapid changes in weather isn't optional. It's essential.

Why It Matters

• Wet Roads = Less Grip: Even light rain can reduce traction and increase braking distance.

• *Chilly Mornings, Warm Afternoons*: Layering matters—sweating under heavy gear or freezing without it can both ruin your focus.

• *Visibility Drops Fast*: Fog, mist, and low light can appear quickly, especially in mountain passes or coastal areas.

• *Wind Gusts*: Sudden side winds can push your line, especially when riding through open areas or across bridges.

Gear Tips for Junuary

Pack Waterproof Layers: A lightweight rain jacket over your regular gear can save the day.

Gloves Matter: Keep an extra pair—wet hands are cold hands, and cold hands mean less control.

Anti-Fog Treatment: Apply to your visor or goggles—fogging at a red light can become a real hazard.

Saddlebag Essentials: Carry a microfiber cloth, clear visor, and waterproof phone pouch.

Riding Tips for Unpredictable Days

• *Ride Smooth*: In wet or windy conditions, smooth throttle, brake, and clutch control are more important than ever.

• *Slow Down in Rain*: Painted lines and metal surfaces become slick. Give yourself extra stopping distance.

• **Check Your Tire Pressure**: Cold temps in the morning affect PSI. A quick check can make a big difference in handling.

• Be Visible: Use hi-vis accents or reflective gear. Junuary skies can turn dark quickly.

Stay Ahead of the Weather

Before your ride:

V Check weather hourly, not just daily. Adjust your plans if necessary.

Let someone know your route ahead of time and when you expect to be back.

Set up weather alerts on your phone - using your weather app or use Alertable for extreme warnings.

Don't let a little bad weather catch you by surprise this season. Junuary is a West Coast classic, but with the right prep, you'll stay warm, dry, and in control—ready for summer when it finally arrives.
