Post-Winter Hazards on the Road


Managing Slippery Surfaces - Gravel, Wet Roads & Oil Slicks

As we (finally) ease into spring riding, the roads might feel clear—but looks can be deceiving. After a long winter, many streets and highways are still littered with gravel, debris, and oil buildup, not to mention fresh potholes and cracks from frost damage. These conditions can catch even experienced riders off guard, especially in corners or during braking.

Common Spring Hazards

Gravel & Sand: Left over from winter sanding, especially at intersections, turns, and shoulder areas.

Wet Roads: Spring showers and thawing can create slippery conditions, even on warm days.



Potholes & Cracks: Caused by freeze-thaw cycles, often hidden by water or shadows.

Safety Strategies

- Slow In, Smooth Out: Approach corners cautiously. Avoid hard braking or sudden throttle changes on uncertain surfaces.
- Scan Ahead: Look well beyond your front tire. Spot the shiny patch, the gravel shimmer, or the dark crack *before* you're on top of it.
- Grip the Tank, Not the Bars: Stay loose on the handlebars—tense arms reduce your ability to react.

- Ride the Line You Know: In curves, aim for the cleanest, most stable line. Avoid riding in the center of the lane where oil often collects.
- Brake Gently on Slippery Surfaces: Use both brakes evenly and progressively. ABS helps—but it's not magic.
- Route Planning: Be cautious on unfamiliar roads, especially rural routes or construction zones that may not be maintained yet.

Spring riding can be some of the year's most rewarding—but only if you stay alert and ride within the limits of the road conditions. *Ride Free, Stay Safe!*

Van HOG has donated \$540 towards the foundation. 18 participants = \$30 will be added to your fundraising total


