FINANCE REPORT:

Frank, our Treasurer is away on vacation at this time. So the following is a rough calculation only. Our Balance as of June 1 was \$2,088.21. Our income during the month of June is \$1,137.93 (Deeley's Show 'n Shine BBQ and 50/50 proceeds) plus 7 new memberships and

\$80.00 from the June meeting 50/50 draw. Our expenses during the month of June were \$400.13 (BBQ supplies). Our net income for June 2012 was \$957.80. This leaves a balance in our account as of July 1, 2012 of \$3046.01 approximately. We also have 145 members in the Chapter.
