NEWS from TREV DEELEY MOTORCYCLES (CHAPTER SPONSOR):

Jennifer from the MotorClothes Department, brought greetings:

- Vancouver Motorcycle Show – Jan 24th – 26th – Tradex Centre in Abbotsford. The show this year has been shortened by one day. Times are Fri – 10 am to 9 pm, Sat - 10 am to 8 pm, Sun - 10 am to 5 pm. Tickets can be purchased from Trev Deeley Motorcycles at a cost of \$10.00 or you can purchase them at the door for \$14.00.
- “Ride to Live” for Prostate Cancer raffle tickets are now available at Trev Deeley Motorcycles.
- Coupons are being mailed out for the “Take on Winter” promotion. With the purchase of \$100 or more of genuine products from the MotorClothes collection, receive a free Harley-Davidson toque.
- The Parts and Service department is holding a “LED Lighting” Workshop on Jan 18th, at 1pm . If you attend, you will be eligible for 15% off “LED Lights”.

Guests:

Ernie Dau – BCCOM, has replaced Adele Tompkins as President. BCCOM has lowered their membership Rates. Single is \$30.00, Couple is \$35.00

- They are trying to bring A.I.M. and BCCOM closer together. One way to do this is to offer anyone who is a current member of either club, and who renews their membership in either club, will receive \$5.00 off their membership rate for that club.
- “Winter Tires for Motorcycles” is a topic that is in the forefront for BCCOM this year. If you live outside the Lower Mainland (North of Squamish or East of Chilliwack), then you are subject to the motor vehicle laws on the use of Winter Tires on your Motorcycle. Between October and May, you are required to have “Winter Tires” on your vehicle (and this includes Motorcycles). This law is relevant on Hwy 99 north of Squamish, Hwy 1 east of Chilliwack, and all other roads that are outside of the Lower Mainland.

- However, this does not pertain to Hwy 7 (Lougheed Highway between Mission and Hope. If you hear of anyone who has been ticketed because they did not have Winter Tires on their motorcycle while riding between October and May, and have been riding on the highways noted above, please have them call the BCCOM office (604-580-0111) as soon as possible.
- The Kamloops Harley Davidson demo days were cancelled in October 2013 because they were caught on the Coquihalla Highway, Lac La Jeune exit, by the RCMP, without winter tires on the 2014 motorcycle demo bikes.
- Please contact your MLA for the Province of B.C., and lobby them to have this law changed.
- The B.C. Government says that “Motor Assisted Cycles” (pedal bikes that also have an engine (electric or gas)) are affecting stats for motorcycle insurance rates.
- We are still lobbying the government for Transferable Plates for Motorcycles.
- The BCCOM mandate is to support motorcyclists in the Province of B.C. with the rider’s legal issues regarding the Motor Vehicle Act of B.C. If anyone has been served with a “Notice of Inspection” for their motorcycle, please comply with the request and then contact BCCOM with regards to challenging the issue.

Finances:

Frank reported that we have \$2581 dollars in the bank at the beginning of January j2014. We had some issues with the Executive Inn, Burnaby, at our Xmas Party, so they have given us a 30% discount in the price of the party both towards the 2013 Xmas Party as well as the 2014 Xmas Party.
