#### **NEWS from TREV DEELEY MOTORCYCLES (CHAPTER SPONSOR):**

Two members of **BACA (Bikers Against Child Abuse)** attended today's meeting – **Two Bears** (President, Vancouver Chapter) and **Eagle Eye** (Secretary, Vancouver Chapter). They spoke of the organization's existence to create a safer environment for abused children, to empower children to not feel afraid of the world in which they live. They work in conjunction with local and state officials already in place to protect children. They do not condone the use of violence or physical force, however if circumstances arise where they are the only obstacle preventing a child from further abuse, they will stand ready to be that obstacle.

The organization has 15 Chapters in Canada and 200 Chapters and Temp Charters in 8 countries around the world. They were established in 1995 out of Utah.
