- Jenn encouraged members to attend the HOG<sup>®</sup> Regional Rally in Chilliwack in 2 weeks and for everyone to ride safe!
- HOG<sup>®</sup> pins were circulated to those who purchased them; if anyone else wishes to order one, please see Jenn at TDMC. The price for members is \$10 with your Chapter picking up any additional costs.
- New generic HOG<sup>®</sup> merchandise has been purchased and is on display in the glass case at the front of the store near Kyoko's station.

- Harley-Davidson Canada has brought back the 0.99% APR finance rate on all 2016 Street and Touring models (excluding CVO and Trike). Talk to any of the sales reps for more details. Note that .99% financing is on approved credit.
- On June 12<sup>th</sup>, TDMC hosted their 20<sup>th</sup> annual Show N' Shine. There was a total of 57 bike entries, 300 bikes parked around the dealership and close to 500 people in attendance. A big thank you to everyone who volunteered their time to help make this event a huge success.
- Sunday, July 10<sup>th</sup> Bikers Against Bullies will be holding their 4<sup>th</sup> annual rally in the TDMC west parking lot. Registration opens at 10:00 a.m. with kickstands up at 11:00 a.m. There will be a BBQ, live band, DJ, 50/50 draw and a silent auction all lasting till 3:00 pm. Registration is \$25.
- The PNE prize home will be having an open house the weekend of July 15/16. Be sure to check it out as part of the prize package includes two brand new Harley-Davidson Street 500s.

- Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup> In honour of BC Day, TDMC will be on holiday hours from 10:00 a.m to 4:30 pm with the Service Dept closed all day. The entire store will be back to regular hours on Tuesday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Saturday, August 6<sup>th</sup> TDMC will be hosting the "Hogust Party" in their west parking lot. Not a lot of details are currently available, but they are looking into having a motorcycle stunt show, a pig roast and another beer garden. - TDMC parts and service departments are now selling Amsoil and Redline motorcycle oils in addition to their Harley-Davidson Syn 3 and standard oils.

If you have an altered exhaust system and are wondering what your sound level is, come by the service department and they will test what decibel level you are running at. As a point of reference, the Harley-Davidson Screamin' Eagle Street Cannons idle at 83db and run at 87db at 2,000 rpms.

- 2. Because of rain today, the Chapter's 28<sup>th</sup> anniversary ride to Abbotsford for ice cream was cancelled. Also, because the MDC group has disbanded due to lack of volunteers, and because they did our pancake breakfast to honour our anniversaries, the regular brunch at TDMC was also cancelled. Members were therefore invited to brunch at the Knight & Day Restaurant. About 12 members attended.
- 3. The Western Regional HOG<sup>®</sup> Rally in Chilliwack July 14, 15 & 16. The rally is fast approaching. You can still register at <u>www.westernregionalrallly.hog.com</u>. The cost for the Rally is now \$90. This covers the Cinema and meal on Thursday night, the dinner/dance of Friday night (BC/DC), the closing ceremonies and dance (Tainted Lovers) on Saturday night, and a rally pin. As well, there will be guided tours on Friday and Saturday to Hells Gate and Fort Langley. In addition to those rides, there are "Self-Guided Rides" to various areas of the Lower Mainland, Fraser Valley, Fraser Canyon, Hope-Princeton, Lower Thompson Valley, and Duffy Lake Loop.
