##### **Kyle, Promotions and Events Coordinator, Trev Deeley Motorcycles®**

- **May 28<sup>th</sup>** - The Ride to Live for Prostate Cancer on May 28<sup>th</sup> raised over \$134,000 this year, bringing its 9 year total to \$1.3M. There were over 800 bikes with 500-600 leaving from TDMC alone. Darwin, Scotty and Mike all participated in this ride and many photos are now on Facebook. Thanks to everyone who helped make this a great success.
- **Sunday, June 4<sup>th</sup>** – Deeley's Motorcycle Exhibition will be closing its exhibit of Cycles in Cinema, and will be preparing for the next exhibit over the coming weeks. TDMC provided a number of pairs of tickets for any members who wished to take advantage of this for this weekend only.
- **Friday, June 9<sup>th</sup>** – CFOX will be holding their "Grills Gone Wild" event in the West parking lot from 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. TDMC is expecting 500-1000 vehicles to pass through their parking lot, which means traffic will be very busy. Please leave early to accommodate for this – we recommend everyone ride if you can. Parking will only be available in the East lot. The event will be cleared out by 11:00 a.m.

**Member Presentation:** Dan Cameron, Retired BC Professional Paramedic

As you know, a portable defibrillator has been purchased through the generosity of our member and TDMC. It is currently located in the first aid room at Trev Deeley Motorcycles. Anyone with a Level 2/3 First Aid will already be trained in the use of the defibrillator.

Member Dan Cameron provided great information in a brief presentation about this unit. He noted that the unit has a 3-8 year shelf life before batteries need to be changed, but must be changed after each use. He recommended that the unit be tagged, dated and signed to ensure it is always ready for use.

He also noted that for every minute of delay in responding to an individual in cardiac distress, there is a 10% loss of brain function. He spoke about the signs of cardiac arrest - if someone collapses, is unresponsive and not breathing, begin CPR (with compressions given to the tune of "Stayin' Alive" by the BeeGees!). Call for help and have someone bring the defib unit asap. The unit has verbal commands to walk providers through the process. Dan has offered to provide more detailed training to anyone who wishes to learn more about this lifesaving device. Please let Chris know if you are interested. He will also be providing additional training for TDMC staff members.
