NEWS from TREV DEELEY MOTORCYCLES® (CHAPTER SPONSOR):

Chris Wong-Moon, Trev Deeley Motorcycles®,

- VOLUNTARY RECALL ON 2017 and 2018 Touring, Trike and CVO touring motorcycles, as well as 2017 Softail and CVO Softail motorcyles for a secondary clutch activator. Work will take about 2 hours to complete. Contact the service department who will run your VIN to see if you bike is affected. If so, TDMC will pickup and return your bike within the lower mainland.
- Limited **storage** is still available; see Chris as soon as possible as there are only about 12 more spots available.
- A new program by Harley-Davidson for 2017 and 2018 bikes, extending your factory warranty to add custom work and upgrades. 

A Few Tips to Remember for the Start of the Next Riding Season

The riding season has come to an end for most people. I would like to pass along a few tips to keep in mind for the next time you roll your motorcycle out of the garage:

- When riding in a group, always ride within your comfort-zone. That is, ride at your own speed; make your own decisions and do not blindly follow the motorcycle in front of you; do not assume the riders around you know what they are doing; and ride your own ride.
- Low-speed maneuvering is a very important skill for riding in congested areas as well as negotiating parking. So, at the start of the next riding season, find a parking lot to practice low-speed maneuvers and especially parking to avoid low-speed tip-overs. Lowspeed tip-overs can also occur when the rider experiences fatigue and exhaustion and is physically not able to handle the motorcycle at low-speeds or forget to put the jiffystand (side stand) down when dismounting the motorcycle.¹
- We are all tempted to ride past our comfort-zone for the thrill of it. It is OK to take risks but only take risks when it is safe to do so in the right time and place.
- Finally, motorcycles will teach you there are gaps between understanding something; applying that knowledge; and the physical skills required to act/react successfully. A motorcycle will teach you that you are not as good as you hope you are².
