### *Harley - Davidson's Travelling Museum*

truck will be arriving in Vancouver at Deeley's on Sat, Oct 21/89. Don't miss this chance to see 86 years of history of Harley-

Davidson. It is housed in a specially built 48 ft. trailer hauled by a cab over Freightliner tractor. The trailer has special alarms and three generators to keep a constant humidity of 70% and temp at 70 degrees F. to protect and preserve the motorcycles on display. These 7 bikes represent H-D various eras and photographs from the H-D archives. The bikes are: 1907 single; 1909 V-twin; 1927 JD; 1936 "Knucklehead"; 1946 "Panhead"; 1954 KH and 1974 FX. The museum uses other world events to enhance the display. Mark the date down, Oct. 21/89. If you can't make it down on Sat. other dates in the area are: Victoria Oct. 17/18 (not confirmed), O'Hara's Oct. 20th and Chilliwack Oct 22nd.

The first annual Northwest regional HOG rally was a great success from the point of view of attendance and the enjoyment of the participants. The weather cooperated fully, giving us cloudy conditions on Saturday and sunshine on Sunday.

I estimate that about 10 or 12 people from the Vancouver HOG group showed, with Joel leading 3 bikes and the rest of the people coming in individually. One of the highlights of the trip for me was catching up with Spooner and the folks from Kamloops (it wasn't hard, they travel pretty slowly), and riding with them into Aberdeen and then into the rally site in Hoquiam. Normally, this wouldn't really turn my crank, but Spooner had all of his bikes stop in Hoquiam and fasten custom-made Canadian flags with the HOG logo and Kamloops Chapter Identification inside the

maple leaf! It looked absolutely terrific, and we got a round of applause when we arrived at the rally meeting site in Hoquiam. I think that this is definitely something worthwhile for our group to get.

The rally itself went well, with the entire group of 300 odd bikes riding from Hoquiam to Ocean Shores, an impressive sight (and sound). I don't know what went on in the afternoon, as I had not reserved a room or brought along camping gear, so I spent the entire afternoon looking for a room. Dinner that night was very good, and the dance was also, though a lot of folks seemed to flake out early.

Sunday there was a good but slow breakfast and then a performance by the Cossacks motorcycle drill team from Seattle. Those guys were absolutely great, and their old flathead and panhead Harleys were a lovely sight.

My one negative comment about the whole ride has to do with Ocean Shores itself. I went into a couple of the stores there in my riding gear and was quickly given the bum's rush. I suspect that bikers are more welcome in towns without a large tourist industry than in a resort area like Ocean Shores.
