NEWS From Trev Deeley Motorcycles (Chapter Sponsor):

This is a reminder for the members to register for the "HOG THE ROAD" Contest. Members of the chapter are able to register their motorcycle odometer reading with the Service Department advisors at Trev Deeley Motorcycles. If you have more than one motorcycle that you ride during the year, then you can combine the mileage. The contest runs until Oct 31, 2011. On or before, Oct 31, 2011, you must provide the Service Department advisors with your final mileage for the year. The person who "rides" the most kilometres in the year will win a "New Set of Tires" for their motorcycle. Everyone who "rides" more than 10,000 miles in the year will have their name put into a hat, and one name will be drawn to win a "New Set of Tires" for their motorcycle. Both sets of tires must be installed by Trev Deeley Motorcycle Service Department. All entrants who have ridden over 10,000 kms will receive one draw entry. Additional entry tickets will be issued for each 10,000 kms ridden. The prizes will be given out at the "Christmas Party" on November 26, 2011.
