HEALTH REGULATION UPDATE

On April 8, 2022 at 12:01 am, further restrictions will be lifted:

- Proof of vaccination will no longer be required under public health order to access businesses, events, and services.
- Individual businesses and event organizers can choose to continue requiring proof of vaccination for entry.

Wearing masks in public indoor settings is not required by public health. Wearing a mask is a personal choice. Masks are encouraged on public transit and BC Ferries, but not required. Individual businesses and event organizers can choose to continue requiring masks on their premises. It's important that we respect the choices of people, businesses, and one another.

We will continue to monitor the provincial health advisories, working with our sponsor TDMC, and doing our best in 2022 for the health & safety of all members.

OFFICER REPORTS

SAFETY REPORT

TERESA VARTY Safety Officer

Ensure a safe ride, every ride with the TCLOCK checklist:

T- Tires and Wheels

- Tires- Check tread depth, wear, and air pressure
- Wheels- See if any spokes are loose or if the rim is bent or cracked. See if it turns freely but is not loose on the axle.

C- Control Levers

- Inspect levers. Verify they are not bent or broken and move easily.
- Check cables for fraying and lubricate them.
- Check hoses for cracks, leaks, bulges, and chaffed areas
- Make sure the throttle moves freely. Closes easily. Lube if needed.

L- Lights & Battery

• Check that the battery terminals are clean and tight, and that the electrolyte level is correct.

Plus make sure the vent tube is hooked to the vent outlet and not kinked

- Check the turn signals and brake lights for proper operation. Make sure the lenses are not cracked or broken
- Headlight- Check for proper operation and alignment

O- Oil Levels

Check engine oil level plus transmission and primary drive fluid levels

C- Chassis

- Steering Head-Move handlebars back and forth to check for tight spots or binding.
- Hold the front brake and rock the bike front to back to check for any free play in the neck bearings.
- Suspension- Check the front forks and the rear shocks for smooth travel and right air pressure (If equipped)
- Belt- Check tension and visually inspect for any rocks or other objects stuck in it.
- Fasteners- Check for any loose nuts or bolts and tighten if needed

K- Kickstand

Side stand- Check for ease of operation and spring action.

** Shared from ICBC: as we are heading into peak riding season, some things to keep in mind:

Observation

- looks well ahead in the direction of intended travel
- scans at intersections
- shoulder checks and mirror checks
- does a 360-degree vision check when backing up.

Hazard perception

• identifies hazards in the riding environment.

Speed control

- uses the throttle, brakes, clutch, and gears smoothly
- chooses and maintains a consistent and appropriate speed.

Steering

- steers smoothly and accurately
- maintains good riding posture and balance
- keeps both hands on the hand grips when possible
- keeps both feet on the pegs while riding
- stops with the front wheel straight.

Space margins

- keeps appropriate space margins in front and on both sides
- chooses safe lane positions
- stops accurately.

Communication

- correctly uses turn signals, hand signals, eye contact, brake light and horn
- rides with maximum visibility.

Albert thanked all the executive for the work they have done and the zoom meetings that took place through the pandemic. He also welcomed **Murray Thompson** to the road captain team.

There will be a laminated "10 Commandment" page for road captains, available with Kyoko, at the west desk at TDMC. These commandments have tips for new riders that the road captain should go over with them, as well as the top 10 items they should go over with the entire ride group.
