HAPPY NEW YEAR to all members of the Vancouver HOG® Chapter!

Well, here we go again! As of December 22, 2021, indoor organized gatherings of any size are no longer permitted. That means our in-person HOG® meetings are suspended & meetings via ZOOM will resume until further notice. TDMC remains open with the requirement of face masks but the Deeley Exhibition meeting room is closed.

The Van HOG® Membership Mixer following our meeting today is also postponed. However, we will have a table set up in TDMC, as we did the last couple of years, for people to drop in to renew their memberships from 11:00-1:00. As well, members have a couple of other options to renew: Come into TDMC anytime during store hours & see Kyoko at the west desk, OR download the membership form from our FB page, e-transfer \$20 & email a readable version of the form to lynhart@telus.net.

As well, HOG® events such as dinners & pub nights have changed. Although places like bars, nightclubs and lounges that do not serve meals must close, other venues that serve food such as pubs & lounges can remain open for business with the following restrictions:

- A maximum of 6 people at a table
- 2 metres *or* physical barriers between tables
- Customers must stay seated and cannot move between or visit other tables
- No dancing
- Normal liquor service hours
- Masks are required when not seated at a table

This is the time to prepare, so that we are ready physically and mentally when we renew our motorcycle insurance for the riding season. With that in mind and taking into account covid protocols, we can get a head-start!

Please consider signing up for a "BIKER DOWN" course at http://www.bikerdown.ca. It is a FREE 3-hour course covering accident scene management and first aid for motorcyclists. I have been in contact with Steve Reed (on the board of BikerDown.ca) and this is what he says:

We would love to host a VIP session(s) and make it a special experience for your HOG chapter. Obviously covid is giving us some headwinds but I see us launching before the new riding experience is upon us. If you want to encourage your group to pre-register at the website, they can put in the city field HOG Vancouver so we can see the number of registrants and coordinate days/times etc with you in the near future. The course is FREE. It's all about empowering riders to save another rider's life and it doesn't matter if you have zero or a ton of experience. We welcome anyone who sits on a bike; front or pillion. Accident scenes need all hands on deck!

We started the year with the Chapter bank account being switched out to a new bank, one that is not only closer to the sponsor dealership, but that has greater accessibility for use. If we were to look down at the Chapter Finances as a whole, we started off 2021 with about \$4000. With a Chapter donation of \$1000 to the Indian Residential School Survivors Society in the summer of 2021 and monthly draws for both birthdays and membership cards, we ended the year with over \$3000. It took a bit to put it together, but as the end result was to get people out riding, I'd say it was a success in that.

2022 will present its challenges for us, at least in the early months of the year, but I hold to the idea that this will hopefully end soon and we as a chapter can once again socialize face to face, and enjoy life. Oh, and by the way, keep your eyes peeled for the 2nd annual Treasurer's Ride 2022, coming to a summer near you!! Thank you to everyone for all the support, kind words and your participation in helping make our Chapter what it is!!
