HEALTH REGULATION UPDATE – JULY 1ST

Recreational travel is now permitted in Canada. It is recommended to still wear a mask indoors until you are fully vaccinated. There are no more limits to group size for dining. **Indoor organized gatherings (such as our meetings) are limited up to 50 or 50% capacity, if there is 2m distance between people.** Outdoor organized gatherings are limited to 5000 people - or 50% capacity, whichever is greater. Personal gatherings have no limits. Sports & exercise events, fairs & festivals all return to normal. Phase 4 update due Sept 7, 2021

LYTTON RELIEF RUN Tammy Bade, Events Officer

Much of the community of Lytton, BC has been devastated & destroyed by a wildfire caused by the record-breaking heatwave. 90% of the village has burned, including the town centre. As many as 1,500 people from Lytton and surrounding areas were ordered to evacuate, many with as little as 15 minutes notice. Families have lost their homes & belongings. A major emergency operations centre & evacuee reception site has been established in Merritt, and evacuees were being urged to register there. Tammy thanks everyone. Donation locations are no longer accepting donations. Suggestions for other organizations were received, including homeless shelters, transition houses, the Union Gospel Mission & Cash donations to the Lytton Go Fund Me page.

Safety Report: RICK & TAMMY BADE Safety Officers
 MYTHS ABOUT MOTORCYCLE SAFETY THAT NEED TO GO AWAY (Part 5 of 7)
 Myth: Roads and Streets are Safer than the Highways

- Although it's true that you go a lot faster on highways than on city streets and roads, the smoother flow of traffic, wider lanes and lack of oncoming traffic remove many of the common dangers that motorcyclists run into.

MOTORCYCLE-RELATED FINES AND PENALTY POINTS (Part 5 of 9)

- Ride motorcycle without required helmet \$138 fine & 0 points

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY TIPS FOR RIDING THROUGH THE MOUNTAINS (Part 5 of 10)

- Never use the front brake first.

 When a Raccoon leaps out at you, a semi decides to change lanes or your exit pops up out of nowhere and it's time to hit the brakes. Never hit the front brakes first. You must train your instincts to always go for the rear brake first. If you grab the front brake with any kind of force, YOU WILL EAT IT. This is not a question; it is a fact. Brake first with your foot, not your hand you will be glad you did.
