SAFETY REPORT

TERESA VARTY Safety Officer

Some general thoughts on motorcycle riding safety:

Remember you are harder to spot than a car. By staying aware, and adjusting the way we ride, we take the idea of our own safety out of other hands.

- 1. Make sure before each ride that you have checked your tires, signals, fluids, brakes, kick stand.
- 2. Ride your own ride ride with people you know and trust.
- **3.** Be Seen motorcycle reflective gear (and always your helmet, ATGATT).
- 4. Wear the right gloves right fit and thickness.
- 5. Never ride tired, decide on a sensible km / time interval, and stop to stretch, pee break, stretch and fluid intake.
- 6. Keep a sensible distance between yourselves and those around you.
- 7. Have an escape route (at traffic lights, intersections).
- 8. Look where you want to go head up, look through the turns.
- 9. Be wary of semi-trucks and their 'drag'.
- **10.** When on a new route, take it easy, and know your limits.
- **11.** Ride with snacks, water, and first aid kit.
