HEALTH REGULATION UPDATE

- Proof of vaccination is no longer required under public health order to access businesses, events and services.
- Individual businesses and event organizers can choose to continue requiring proof of vaccination for entry.

SAFETY REPORT

Some interesting data from motorcycling.ca:

Interest in motorcycling has increased significantly over the past two years. Sales of all types of motorcycles went up by 8.45% in 2021. Street bike sales were up an amazing 18.1% last year, following an even larger jump in 2020, when lockdowns fueled sales for what could be considered the ultimate "socially distanced" form of travel and recreation.

May is Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month

With warmer weather, it's time to remind everyone to be on the alert and to share the road with motorcyclists. This includes a few basics:

Get training. Practice your skills. Develop safe riding habits. Ride within your skill limits and according to conditions. These are the best ways to ensure you can safely enjoy all the pleasures of riding.

In early Spring there is often gravel and debris on the roads left over from Winter, and that can make cornering, braking, and stopping safely more difficult.

And there's ATGATT – All The Gear All The Time. Wearing the right safety gear and appropriate clothing is a must for all riders.

Motorists are reminded to Watch Out for motorcycles on the road. May is the start of peak riding season and there are more motorcycles on our city streets, country roads, and highways. Take that second look to better judge the speed and distance of a motorcyclist in your vicinity. Always check your mirrors and blind spots, especially before turning or changing lanes. Allow extra room to avoid cutting off a motorcyclist and allow extra space when driving behind a motorcyclist, and stay off your phone, which is a major distraction.

This is to consider the lack of light later in the evening, so there is less of a chance of riding in the dark as this stops some riders from taking part. We will also be meeting at a new spot for the Valley rides. We will meet at Tynehead Esso, at 96th Ave and 168th St. This change is due to how many individuals are coming from the GVRD. This is a closer meeting spot. Please make sure to have a full tank of gas and an empty bladder when you arrive!

Leif Erickson – Leif used to make artificial eyes, and saw many motorcyclists lose them due to rocks or bugs. He has sunglasses/safety glasses available for \$15 pair, and the money goes to the charity. He'll bring more next meeting, if possible.

He also wanted to thank **Doug Miller**, the chapter's sweep on most rides. When on a ride last summer, Doug noticed his tail and break light were burnt out. He offered to ride behind Leif to go to Lordco, to get parts. Leif ended up replacing his brake lights for an LED set, which flashes 5 times before going solid, and the turn signal does a double flash. Much Safer! Thanks Doug, for taking care of our members!

Leif also thanked **Craig Heale** for reminding us last month to check our tires. Leif changed his and they are now fantastic!

Leif shared a book recommendation, *Proficient Motorcycling* by David Huff from Seattle. The author interviewed old time riders who are still riding to get great tips. Great Book! Can be purchased on Abebooks.com or Amazon.

Polar Batteries is a great retail outlet to purchase batteries, as they are hard to find at the moment.
