HEALTH REGULATION UPDATE

As of December 22, 2021, indoor organized gatherings of any size are no longer permitted. That means our in-person HOG® meetings are suspended & meetings via ZOOM will resume until further notice. TDMC remains open with the requirement of face masks but the Deeley Exhibition meeting room is closed.

HOG® events such as dinners & pub nights are still being held but have changed. Although places like bars, nightclubs and lounges that do not serve meals must close, other venues that serve food such as pubs & lounges can remain open for business with the following restrictions:

- A maximum of 6 people at a table
- 2 metres *or* physical barriers between tables
- Customers must stay seated and cannot move between or visit other tables
- No dancing
- Normal liquor service hours
- Masks are required when not seated at a table

To date, there haven't been any complications or issues at the venues with the new regulations. Members are attending & enjoying the events.

We'll be monitoring the provincial health advisories, working with our sponsor TDMC, and doing our best in 2022. Please be patient while we continue to consider the health & safety of all members.

SAFETY REPORT

TERESA VARTY Safety Officer

Yes, we are all dreaming of the spring when we can be out consistently riding (I am sure some have been out on the past cool but sunny days lately), but for those of us dreaming of the summer months, now is the time to start getting mind, body, motorcycle and our gear ready.

Motorcycle riding requires strength & endurance, so being physically ready to ride is important. What does that look like – getting fit or maintaining a level of fitness. Strength training and even some stretching for flexibility. Your body will thank you.

Motorcycle – maybe now is the time to reserve your spot at Trev Deely for a spring tune up, especially if your bike has been sitting for the winter

Gear – check over your riding gear, boots, and helmets. If you haven't done this in the fall, now is the time to wash your gear, check for any tears or rips, reseal all the GoreTex parts, and air out your boots and helmet. Speaking of boots: a pro tip for funky odors is putting a couple of drops of essential tea tree oil on the inside soles. Tea tree is a strong natural bacteria killer and a few drops will eliminate all odors and bacteria that might have moved in.

Mind – brush up on your skills, do an online course of signs, road hazards – interesting to see what we know (or don't) https://www.yourlibrary.ca/driving/ Do you know the 'universal' motorcycle hand signals – especially when group riding (see attached graphic).

Please consider signing up for a "BIKER DOWN" course at http://www.bikerdown.ca.

It is a FREE 3-hour course covering accident scene management and first aid for motorcyclists.

I have been in contact with Steve Reed (on the board of BikerDown.ca) and this is what he says:

We would love to host a VIP session(s) and make it a special experience for your HOG chapter. Obviously covid is giving us some headwinds but I see us launching before the new riding experience is upon us. If you want to encourage your group to pre-register at the website, they can put in the city field **HOG Vancouver** so we can see the number of registrants and coordinate days/times etc with you in the near future. The course is FREE. It's all about empowering riders to save another rider's life and it doesn't matter if you have zero or a ton of experience. We welcome anyone who sits on a bike; front or pillion. Accident scenes need all hands-on deck!

ROAD CAPTAIN REPORT

Road Captains will be coming up with guidelines for the beginning of rides. This will be consistent so new riders will be given the same information at the beginning of all rides. Wednesday night rides starting May 18th, will start at the new time of 6:30pm. MOTORCYCLE HAND SIGNALS



LEFT TURN

Arm and hand extending left, palm facing down



RIGHT TURN

Arm out bent at 90° angle up with fist clinched



STOP

Arm out bent at 90° angle down with palm facing back



SLOW DOWN

Arm extended straight out with palm facing down while swinging arm down



SPEED UP

Arm extended straight out with palm facing up while swinging arm upward



HAZARD IN ROAD

On left point with left hand

On right point with right foot



FOLLOW ME

Arm extended straight up with palm facing forward



COME AROUND/ TAKE THE LEAD

Arm extended index finger pointing out while swinging arc from bact to front



PULL OFF

Arm extended index finger pointing out while swinging arc from left to over head



SINGLE FILE

Arm straight up with index finger pointed up



DOUBLE FILE

Arm straight up with index finger and middle finger up



RIDE STAGGERED

Arm straight up with index finger and pinky up



FUEL STOP

Point to fuel tank



COMFORT STOP

Arm extended with clinched fist with short up and down motion



REFRESHMENT STOP

Fingers closed with thumb to mouth



TURN SIGNAL ON

Extend arm while opening and closing hand



POLICE AHEAD

Tap top of head or helmet with palm of hand



Note that they all require that you take a hand of foot off the controls and this may not always be a good idea, so only do so when it is safe. All hand signals use the left hand. Remember that not all motorcycle riders know all these motorcycle hand signals, so many may not heed the warning or information you are attempting to pass along. If you are riding with a group of motorcyclists it is a good idea to go through these hand signals so everyone in your riding group gets the message.
