Fall Riding

During the fall, weather can be a major concern, especially in some parts of the country. Heavy fog, strong winds and rain or even snow can all make it dangerous to ride a motorcycle. With so many trees shedding leaves, this can also be a dangerous time to ride a motorcycle if you lose traction while riding over wet leaves on the road. Also important to be aware of, drivers who don't clear their windows as it will affect their visibility, and they may not see a motorcycle. There are many different risk factors that become especially concerning during the fall months.
