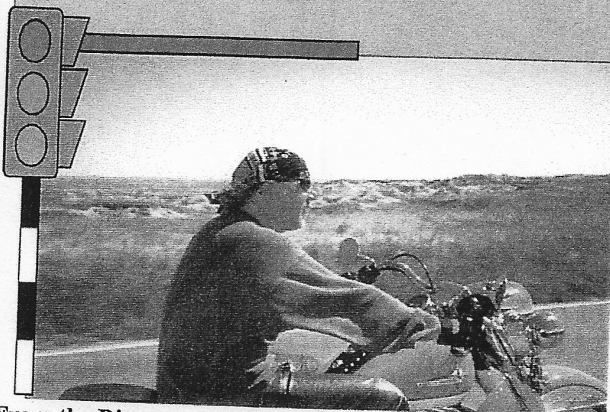


Towards a New Horizon
