SAFETY REPORT

TERESA VARTY Safety Officer

Protect Your Head – Helmet Requirements (from RCMP Motorcycle Safety Sheet)

Motorcycle helmets can reduce the likelihood of a crash fatality and effective in preventing brain injuries. The safety helmet needs to display the proper certification label. Standards for helmet safety are set by a series of tests performed on these critical elements:

- Impact management how well the helmet protects against collisions with large objects
- Helmet position stability whether the helmet will stay in place during an impact
- Straps whether the chin straps and hardware are strong enough to hold the helmet on during impact
- Extent of protection the area of head protected by the helmet

Approved Helmet Standards & Labels

DOT Certification, the symbol DOT constitutes the manufacturer's certification that the helmet conforms to the applicable Federal motor vehicle safety standards. This symbol needs to

appear on the outer surface of the helmet, in a colour that contrasts with the background colour of the helmet.
