From the Merchandise Department: Starting September 9th we are giving 20% off all remaining 120th Harley-Davidson Anniversary clothing and collectibles.

From the Parts & Service Departments: During the month of September, if you purchase a stage 3 or stage 4 kit and have it installed before the end of the year you will receive the labour rate of \$120 an hour for this job.

Motorcycle storage rates will be going up beginning October 1, 2023.

The public rate will move to \$80 a month and HOG member rate will move to \$70 a month. This does not include the fee for storage prep. If you decide to book storage and pay up front in the month of September, you can still receive the existing rate of \$65 a month. Any unused storage will be refunded. Trikes are at double rate.

Will be announced to the public in October.

We will be offering the opportunity to have your motorcycle stored for free this off season. Spending \$3000 on parts and labour before tax will get you 3 months storage free Spending \$4000 on parts and labour before tax will get you 4 months storage free Spending \$5000 on parts and labour before tax will get you 5 months storage free. Only condition is that the work is done during the off season while the bike is in storage.

TDMC is closed September 30th on the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

SAFETY REPORT

On our Poker Run Ride (fabulously organized by Rick and Tammy - thank you!), going through the tunnels on Hwy 1 just outside Hope, we were riding staggered formation, and Rick and Tammy's bike got 'ensnared' by netting. Thankfully, Albert was fully aware of what happened and motioned to Rick and Tammy to pull over (outside the tunnel), where a serious problem was averted.
