SAFETY REPORT

TERESA VARTY Safety Officer

It's the start of riding season, so bring on the group rides!

Our road captains do an incredible job of keeping us safe on rides, they follow the agreed upon pre-ride checklist, are experienced riders themselves and do what they can to give an awesome group ride.

With that in mind – as an individual within a group ride, we are all responsible for ourselves and only ourselves.

Something you should be practicing anytime you're on the bike, not just in a group, you're always scanning ahead, checking your mirrors and watching the patterns of other drivers. Don't get lazy just because you're surrounded by your "pack!" Watch your leader. If your group is stuck behind a slow-moving vehicle and the leader starts to peer around them, you can guess that a pass is imminent. Be ready to change lanes or pass quickly, safely and efficiently, keeping the whole group moving. If you're on a multi-lane highway, the sweep rider could move over early and "set a pick" for the riders ahead, keeping the lane open for them to easily slide over.

Even though you're in a group of other riders, you alone are in control of your bike and are therefore on a solo ride. If the group is doing stuff that makes you uncomfortable, don't do it. Ride your own pace, don't run the red light even though the two riders ahead of you did, and if you need to take a break, signal to your group and pull over. And don't attempt an unsafe pass — your group won't leave you behind.

It's a lot easier to ride with people who are predictable. Hold your line, be smooth and steady with your speed and pay attention to your surroundings.

Craig Heale wanted to let us all know about Todd Copan's Classic & Vintage Swap & Show 'N Shine happening April 30th at the Abbotsford Exhibition Park, 32470 Haida Drive, Abbotsford.

Tammy Bade wanted to get members opinions on if we should stipulate how our clothing donations, she and Rick just collected are utilized by the Union Gospel Mission. We could ask they are given away, or allow them to Sell them in their store, where 70% goes to UGM programs. After discussion, it was decided that Rick and Tammy should make the decision. Also, there was discussion regarding a new building that UGM is building, and how is it being paid for. Will be completed next year in the fall.

Craig Heale also spoke about ICBC no fault insurance. That the rates are down now for ICBC, however people should be aware that if you are not working that there will be no compensation. They do compensate for lost wages, however that is all. Also suggested removing the Insurance sticker from you license plate as it increases the chance of getting a ticket if travelling in the US. Although the ticket doesn't need to be paid, you would still have to follow up to get it cancelled.

Craig Heale also talked about the Annual Toy Run. Says it's not going to happen again as it did in the past. It was too big and involved too many cities. We as a community need to rethink how it can happen. We need to keep it in one city, to only involve one police force. He suggests we organize a meeting with the Christmas Bureau who hosts it, and possibly the City of Burnaby. See if we can get it going again. This is where it was left. If anyone would like to volunteer to try to get things rolling, you are more than welcome.
